The required deposit may be made either by the deposit of any legal tender, by means of a banker's draft or, with the Acting Returning Officer's consent, in any other manner (including by debit or credit card or the electronic transfer of funds). - 5. If any election is contested, the poll will take place on Thursday, 4th July 2024.

- Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024 Applications can be made online: https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate.
- 9. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Darby House, Lawn Central, Telford, TF3 4JA by **5pm on Wednesday**, **26th June 2024**. Applications can be made online: https://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote
- 10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Darby House, Lawn Central, Telford, TF3 4JA by 5pm on Thursday, 4th July 2024. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024.
